The Friends of the Marble Falls Library and the Marble Falls Library Thrift Store are pleased to offer high school seniors an opportunity to apply for one of two \$1,000 scholarships. This application will be considered for both scholarships, but students may receive only one of the two.

Criteria:

1. Applicants must be a graduating senior from Marble Falls High School, Falls Career High School, Faith Academy of Marble Falls, or a home-schooled student completing a homeschool program who would have attended Marble Falls High School.
2. Student must be planning to attend a 2-year or 4-year college or a technical school.
3. An official 7th semester transcript is required. Attach transcript to application in a sealed envelope from the school student attends.
4. Two letters of recommendation are required.
5. Community service is an important part of consideration. Be sure to list all service completed during the 9th – current 12th grade. Include any that you will participate in during the remaining 12th grade year.
6. Recipients of scholarships will be notified in early May 2024.
7. Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the recipient's school.

Submission Instructions:

1. Forms required for submission: completed application, essay, 2 letters of recommendation, and official transcript.
2. Scholarship Applications, hand delivered or mailed, must be received in the Marble Falls Library by 6:00 pm on March 22, 2024. If mailed, applicant is responsible for making sure the application will arrive before the deadline. No late applications will be considered.
